OUR WORK CONTINUES

The North Carolina long term care community began its relationship with the Jessie F. Richardson Foundation (JFRF) and the elders of Nicaragua in 2006. This long-standing partnership has had a tremendous impact on the lives of many elders living in the Hogar de Ancianos, or home of the elders, in Jinotepe. Many of our long term care partners, including providers and vendors, have witnessed these amazing results on the faces of the more than 35 resident elders of the hogar and the staff who work there.

Some of the things we have accomplished with the proceeds made from this event are providing much needed equipment, developing a pharmacy business, replacing water tanks, and building a national training center for eldercare - the only one of its kind in all of Central America.

Perhaps the biggest impact witnessed in Nicaragua is that during this current time of political unrest in the country, where typical channels for donations and services have been brought to a halt, our capacity building and community development efforts have worked! The elders continue to receive essential items like food, water and medicine, and community members continue to be trained to better care for the elders in hogares.
